★ Request documentation pertaining to residential solar PV installations:

- Building requirements
- Fire and safety requirements
- Application form
- Ask if they have an express application format

Notes:



★ Determine whether you will need third party services such as engineering stamps, contractors license, etc.

★ Contact your utility company and inquiry about:

- Interconnection requirements
- Interconnection feasibility and timeline
- Programs and incentives
- Interconnection agreements or contracts

Note: they might ask if the equipment you are using is certified for UL 1741, and the answers is yes. All equipment provided by Boxed Solar is UL certified and meets current interconnection standards.

Notes:

★ Secure your building permit:

- Submit application
- Pay for permit
- Pick up permit or have it mailed to you

★ Complete all documentation required for the interconnection agreement or contract

★ Allow yourself enough time to complete the permitting process before the installation
